

ON, OVER, UNDER, BESIDE

(An outdoor game)

Learning Objective:

Demonstrate understanding of positional language.

Intended Outcome:

Listening and following directions.

Game Objective:

Listen and follow directions.

Instructions:

Play this game as a whole class.

- 1. Define some boundaries for the playing space.
- 2. Teacher calls an instruction, based on positional language, e.g. stand under something, sit beside something red, crawl under something low, stand inside a circle.
- 3. Students follow the instructions.
- 4. Repeat for as long as you like!

Examples of positional language:

On, under, over, beside, in front of, behind, next to, north of, south of, east of, west of, above, beneath, inside, between, outside.

Examples of conditions:

Something green, blue, red. Something hard, soft, wet, squishy.
